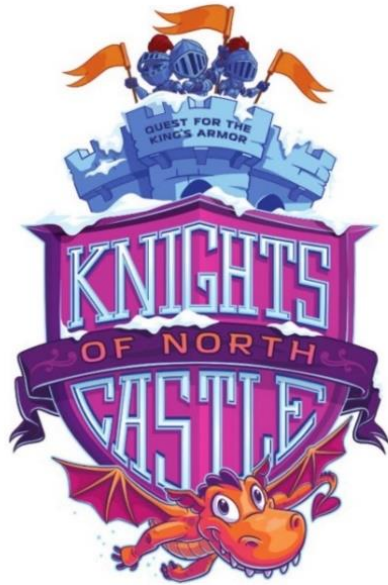


Are you interested in learning more about The Episcopal Church? Have you considered being confirmed, or received, into The Episcopal Church?
